The following is a list of the supplies your child will need in the third grade. If possible, please have them ready for the first day of school in September. Please label ALL supplies with your child's first and last name.

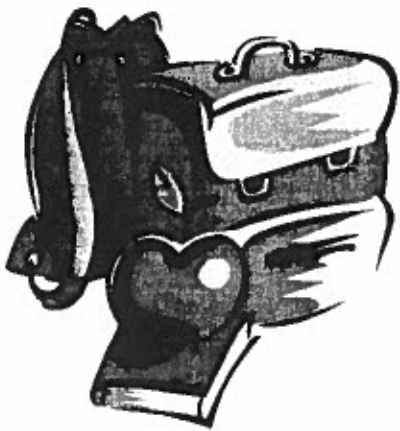
- ❖ 4 large hard covered composition notebooks (PLEASE - NO SPIRALS)

1 12" ruler with inches and centimeters

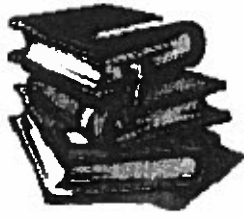
1 school bag, knapsack, or something to hold books
