- Self-Contained Full Day Kindergarten
- Self Contained Grade 1
 - Typically half the students go into mainstream
 - Other half go into inclusion class
- Inclusion Grade 2 (Co-Teaching Model/One Aide)
- Inclusion Grade 3 (Co-Teaching Model/One Aide)
- Inclusion Grade 4 (Co-Teaching Model/One Aide)
- Inclusion Grade 5 (Co-Teaching Model/One Aide)

Transition to JFK

- JFK Administrator will sit in on end of year CSE meetings regarding placement of students into JFK inclusion
- Parents suggested writing anecdotal narratives about their children to share at CSE meetings

JFK Inclusion

- Will try to minimize the number of students in self-contained
- Middle School children have unique needs
- JFK will have higher populations in grades 6 and 7 and will try to place more students in inclusion by grade 8
- JFK is exploring the idea of an MST component to grade 6/7 self-contained

JFK Inclusion

- JFK has inclusion for grades 6, 7, 8 in
 - ELA (Co-Teaching Model)
 - Math (Co-Teaching Model)
 - Social Studies (Co-Teaching Model)
 - Science (Co-Teaching Model)

Transition to BHS

- BHS Administrator will sit in on end of year CSE meetings regarding placement of students into BHS inclusion
- Virtually everyone will be given a shot at inclusion first
- We will err on the side of least restrictive

BHS Inclusion

- 2007-08 BHS has inclusion for grades 9, 10, 11 in
 - ELA (Co-Teaching Model)
 - Math (Co-Teaching/Extended Model)
 - Social Studies (Co-Teaching Model)
 - Science (Co-Teaching Model/Extended grades 9/10 and mainstreamed Environmental or Applied Chem for Grade 11)

Self-Contained

- Combined 9/10 in SS, Math and ELA
- Combined 11/12 in SS, Math and ELA
- Science is Extended in 9/10
