The Homework Center will meet Monday through Thursday from 3:20-3:55. Seventh and eighth graders will meet in Room 122 on Wednesday and Room 120 – Monday, Tuesday and Thursday. Sixth graders will meet in Room 115. Students may NOT leave earlier. If they cannot stay the whole time, they should not attend. Students must enter the room by 3:20pm with all materials ready to work. You will need a pass to enter the room after 3:30pm.

2. Bring all necessary materials for homework.
3. Work quietly.
4. Homework Center starts at 3:20 and ends at 3:55.
5. A student may be asked to leave if they have no work to do or if they are being disruptive.
