

MAIN SUBJECT SUPPLY LIST FOR 6th GRADERS

2009/2010

We do not expect the students to have every supply on the first day of school. By the end of the first week is a more accurate expectation. Students can bring a little in each day. Also, please don't be surprised if your child brings everything home with him/her on the first or second day of school for fear that they might forget something. Once they get acclimated, their backpacks will lighten and their fears will dissipate.

MATH

1. 1" hard cover binder
2. 3 hole pocket folder
3. 5 subject spiral notebook
4. Calculator to be purchased in school in September
5. cm/inch ruler and protractor for later in year

LITERATURE WORKSHOP

1. One 1-1/2" hard cover binder (can be shared with another subject)
2. Four dividers
3. One **Small** stretchy book cover (to be used throughout the year)

6. One 3 hole punch folder (to be kept in binder)

SOCIAL STUDIES

1. One 1-1/2" hard cover binder (can be shared with another subject)

3. A soft-covered binder- 1-1/2" - which will be kept in class as an INACTIVE binder. Please have 3 dividers labeled Q1, Q2, Q3- this binder will hold all their completed packets so they will have them for the June final. Name on the front.

SCIENCE

1. 1-1/2" 3 ring binder (a large binder shared with another class will also suffice)

5. One red pen (for corrections)

PHYSICAL EDUCATION
